General Summary:

To fabricate and assemble company products. Team Members will be trained in all areas of production and perform job requirements according to the specific areas' Standard Operating Procedures.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Fabricate and assemble company products which may include the operation of automated manufacturing equipment in a team environment.
- Work requires the ability to read and understand Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and Process Specifications (PS) in to operate and setup machinery and related systems.
- Participates in continuous process improvement.
- Keep work area neat and clean and follow all established safety guidelines.
- Work within a team structure to achieve Company and department goals.
- Performs additional duties related to specific area assignment.

Job Specifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Possess basic math skills.
- Ability to work with small parts.
- May also require forklift experience, valid Drivers License w/proof of insurance, filing, typing, computer skills, phone skills and knowledge of Federal and State (DOT) hazardous materials regulations.
- 2 Years previous manufacturing experience preferred.
- Must be able to read and understand SOPs.
- Must be able to read and understand English.

Working Conditions: (List items such as noise, temperature, lighting etc.)

- Must wear various safety equipment depending on work area.
